How and where we process your personal data

In such a case, the Controller hereby ensures that the transfer of personal data outside the European Union shall take place in compliance with the applicable legal provisions, for example through the adoption of standard contractual clauses provided by the European Commission that ensure an adequate level of protection of personal data even outside the European Union.
